Cultivating STEM learning opportunities for ALL young children throughout their daily routines and activities in any environment.





Children in rural communities experience challenges gaining access to El services and receiving ongoing support from qualified El providers, which suggest that they may be less likely to experience positive outcomes. (Mello et al., 2016).



Children of migrant and seasonal farmworkers face challenges finding qualified teachers to support their education needs (Rivera-Singletary & Cranston-Gingras, 2020).

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Immigrant children with disabilities face challenges accessing support and services because of language barriers (Khanlou et al., 2015). WHILE ALL CHILDREN ARE MOTIVATED TO LEARN, CHILDREN WHO ARE FROM UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES AND/OR WITH DISABILITIES ARE OFTEN DENIED OPPORTUNITIES TO REACH THEIR FULL POTENTIAL.
