


DISABILITY IN STEM

Every child is different, and these are only suggested age ranges and books. Do what works best for encouraging the child's independent exploration of STEM concepts.

Books can be a powerful way to include ALL children in learning about STEM concepts while offering different experiences and perspectives through with mirrors, windows, and sliding glass doors. These books embrace and celebrate disabilities in STEM learning with engaging illustrations and photos to talk about with your young children.

Each book indicates representation (author, character, STEM innovator) and some that embrace everyday STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) concepts accurately, as well as language availability (e.g., Braille, Korean, Spanish).
